

## Backgrounder

### Warman and Area Infrastructure Projects - Municipal Rural Infrastructure Fund (MRIF)

#### **Town of Blaine Lake – New Sewage Pumping Station \***

**MRIF funding: \$72,124; Project cost: \$144,250**

This project will require building a new sewage pumping station to replace the existing 46-year-old pumping station. The new station will be used to house electrical controls, a new gravity connection line to the sewer main and a backup generator to ensure that the sewage pumping station is operational during power outages.

#### **Town of Dalmeny – Lift Station/Force Main Replacement**

**MRIF funding: \$500,000; Project cost: \$1,506,126**

This project involves replacing the Town of Dalmeny's existing main wastewater lines, which are nearly 40-years-old. It will also require constructing a new wastewater lift station and backup power supply to ensure flows are maintained during power outages.

#### **Town of Duck Lake – Drinking Water Supply and Reservoir Expansion**

**MRIF funding: \$500,000; Project cost: \$1,259,390**

The Town of Duck Lake is expanding its water reservoir to ensure that it has a reserve supply for fire protection and drinking water in times of power outages or system shut downs.

#### **Town of Hague – Upgrade Lift Station \***

**MRIF funding: \$66,500; Project cost: \$133,000**

The Town of Hague is upgrading its 40-year-old wastewater lift station to ensure reliable operation, eliminate untimely interruptions to service, decrease waste backup in residential housing and increase worker safety.

#### **Town of Osler – Lift Station Upgrade, Lagoon Upgrade, and Pipeline to River**

**MRIF funding: \$500,000; Project cost: \$1,070,400**

The Town of Osler is upgrading its lift station, installing back up power, constructing a second force main line to the lagoon and redesigning the lagoon.

#### **R.M. of Rosthern – Road Re-alignment and Construction**

**MRIF funding: \$126,404; Project cost: \$252,810**

The R.M. of Rosthern is constructing and re-aligning Eigenfeld Rd. to accommodate increased heavy haul traffic from the new International Debranning Inc. plant that is being built nearby.

**Town of Warman – Treated Water Storage Reservoir**

**MRIF funding: \$357,500; Project cost: \$715,000**

The Town of Warman is constructing a new water reservoir so the community's quickly growing population can continue to have treated water available while ensuring there are safe reserve volumes for firefighting and other emergencies.

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**Total MRIF funding: \$2,122,528**

**Total project costs: \$5,080,976**
