January 2006 – May 2006	SaskTel	An employee charged personal expenses to a company credit card and used company equipment for personal use.	\$3,545	The police were notified and the employee's term of employment was not extended.
August 25, 2006	SGI	Upon investigation into their depositing status, the Issuer mailed a letter confessing to misappropriating issuing money.	\$8,947	The Issuer's scheduled court appearance was cancelled due to storm. Issuer will be re-served for court appearance. The RCMP have indicated that restitution is being requested.
Sept 27, 2006	SaskPower	There was an act of vandalism by two SaskPower employees in the Weyburn region. The employees damaged SaskPower's transmission and distribution assets.	\$81,000	One employee was terminated and the other employee is suspended without pay pending termination. The matter was reported to the RCMP and is currently before the courts. SaskPower's transmission and distribution assets (other than substations and switching stations) are not insured.
