

APF Science and Innovation Funding Announcement

Total Federal/Provincial Government Investment: \$41.5 million*

University of Saskatchewan: \$27.9 million total investment

- \$9.9 million for new Research Chairs (Carbohydrate Utilization, Process Engineering and Feed Research)
- \$1.2 million to enhance existing Chair positions (Pulse, Beef Industry)
- \$5.8 million for new wing of the Western College of Veterinary Medicine and Prairie Diagnostic Services
- \$1 million for Strategic Research Program equipment
- \$5 million for the new Feed Technology Centre
- \$5 million for a new Grain Innovation Lab at the Crop Development Centre

Prairie Agricultural Machinery Institute (PAMI): \$4.4 million total investment

- \$3.3 million for a new Research Chair (Bio-Energy and Processing)
- \$1.1 million for infrastructure at the Western Beef Development Centre

Prairie Swine Centre

- **\$2.6 million** for infrastructure

Protein, Oil and Starch (POS) Pilot Plant

- **\$3 million** to support operational enhancements

Saskatchewan Research Council (SRC)

- **\$150,000** for Bio-fuel research equipment

***\$3.45 million in additional projects to be finalized shortly**

Note: The full cost of the programming under the Agricultural Policy Framework (APF) is shared 60:40 by the federal and provincial governments over the life of the agreement. Investments are made in five areas or “chapters”: Business Risk Management, Science and Innovation, Food Safety and Quality, Environment and Renewal.
