The flowing river and rising sun reflect the promise made between the First Nation people and includes all the people of this great nation.

The sash is a recognized symbol of the Métis Nation and their people, culture and traditions.

The First Nation medicine wheel represents the healing between all people and the unity we strive towards as nations. The colours are respectful to the directions and meanings reflective of this area.

These symbols were designed in the shape of the Eagle, which captures the spiritual gifts found in music and art.
