

2 Research Drive, INNOVATION PLACE, Regina

This new three story building will provide 71,000 square feet of office space in a multi tenant facility. It will be connected by a main floor walkway to the existing structure at 2 Research Drive, which will be undergoing extensive renovations.

Construction started on July 9 and will create 145 person years of construction employment. The building will be ready for occupancy in fall, 2008. An advanced building design process will provide a modern, energy efficient building that optimizes the use of fresh air and daylight. The building will be constructed to LEED standards – Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design.
