

**Media Backgrounder**  
**Infrastructure Improvements and Updates**  
**East Central Saskatchewan**

- Through the MRIF we are contributing \$33,620 to improving the streets of Dysart. This work includes recapping asphalt, repair failures, making man hole and valve adjustments and leveling dips with hot mix overlay.
- Through the MRIF we are contributing \$145,063 to road reconstruction in the RM of North Qu'Appelle. The Wide Awake road will be reconstructed to provide a safe, efficient transportation corridor for the heavy trucks around Katepwa Lake on Highway 56.
- We are contributing \$59,367 through the MRIF to reconstruct Grid Road 202 next to Hwy 53 in the RM of Garry.
- We are contributing \$175,000 to the Sunrise Health District for improving diagnostic health equipment.
- We are contributing \$750,000 to the Regina Qu'Appelle Health District for improving diagnostic health equipment.
- We are dedicating \$240,000 to install re-locatable classrooms at Balcarres School.
- We are spending \$7.5M over five years to surface 41 km of Hwy 310 from Ituna to Balcarres.
- Balcarres, Hubbard, Katepwa, Cupar, Pasqua Lake, The Gordon First Nation, Kawacatoose First Nation, and all surrounding areas are receiving improved digital cellular service.
- Through the MRIF we are funding \$500,000 to improve the water system in the Yorkton Queen Street Water Treatment Plant to centralize the function of the three existing plants and to expand capacity to 2030.
- We are spending \$800,000 to complete the Yorkton Broadcast Place Renovation Project.
- We are making accessibility improvements to St. Paul's School.
- Yorkton and the surrounding area is receiving improved wireless internet service.
