

Building Communities Program Backgrounder

- Saskatchewan's quality of life is supported by the vibrancy and diversity of the province's cultural, social and recreational activities.
- The Building Communities Program is investing \$100 million over three years to help communities increase cultural and recreational capacity.
- Submissions for support are eligible for up to 25 per cent of total allowable costs which will be based on a combination of eligible per capita contributions and total projected costs.
- The Program has two streams: Stream A – submissions where the total project is more than \$10 million; Stream B – submissions where the total project cost is between \$1 million and \$10 million.
- Submissions over \$10 million are eligible for \$50 per capita plus 15 per cent of total project costs.
- Submissions of between \$1 million and \$10 million will be eligible for \$75 per capita.

Macklin and District Aquatic Centre

The Macklin and District Aquatic Centre is intended to serve the recreational needs of families in and around the Town of Macklin. The facility will include an outdoor pool, a spray pool and a toddler area. Contributing partners include the Government of Canada, the Town of Macklin and surrounding rural municipalities. The Building Communities Program is contributing \$190,050 to the project. Total estimated cost is approximately \$1.6 million.
