Saskatchewan Home Energy Improvement Program (SHEIP) For Low and Moderate-Income Homeowners

The **Saskatchewan Home Energy Improvement Program (SHEIP) for Low and Moderate-Income Homeowners** is a program that provides financial assistance to homeowners in order to help with the costs of energy retrofits such as heating system upgrades, tankless hot water heaters, insulation, and draft proofing, among others.

SHEIP for Low and Moderate-Income Homeowners is funded by the Saskatchewan Housing Corporation (SHC), and provides a top-up grant that is combined with the grants offered through SaskEnergy's Saskatchewan EnerGuide for Houses Program and the federal ecoENERGY Retrofit Initiative.

SHEIP for Low and Moderate-Income Homeowners is intended to encourage low and moderate-income homeowners to undertake energy retrofits that will make their homes more affordable and reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions that contribute to climate change.

SHEIP for Low and Moderate-Income Homeowners Offers:

- A top-up grant of up to \$4,000 in southern Saskatchewan and up to \$4,700 in northern Saskatchewan for homeowners in single, semi-detached, and row house dwellings.
- A top-up grant of up to \$1,000 per unit in the south and up to \$1,200 per unit in the north for homeowners in multi-unit buildings.
- The level of assistance varies by the annual gross household income.

You Are Eligible For SHEIP for Low and Moderate-Income Homeowners If:

- Your annual gross household income from all sources is at or below the income limits as established by SHC.
- You are the owner of the home, and it is your principal residence.

Other Important Details:

- Dwellings must foster independent living. Funds cannot be used for retrofits to personal care homes or similar institutional facilities. Commercial or non-residential components of dwellings are ineligible for assistance.
- Assistance to homeowners is in the form of a top-up grant, which does not have to be repaid. Properties are eligible for maximum funding assistance once within a ten-year period.
- Assistance is not considered as income for tax purposes.
