Online Saskatchewan version of The Real Game	Creation of a Saskatchewan version on the new on-line Real Game in collaboration with the National Life/Work Centre and Saskatchewan Learning. The game will be linked to the Blueprint competencies and include Saskatchewan-specific content and infusion of first Nations and Métis content and perspectives.
