

Cypress Regional Hospital Fact Sheet

Serves 44,000 residents of Cypress Health Region, plus some communities north of the South Saskatchewan River.

- 2004 Saskatchewan Drive, Swift Current
- 87 inpatient beds, plus 2 portable stretcher units
- Newly constructed building, 15,000 square metres (160,000 square feet, increased from 120,000 square feet)
- Staff: approximately 400, including 120 registered nurses
- Physicians with privileges: 53, including 18 specialists, 17 family physicians

First day of patient service: April 27, 2007

Grand opening ceremony: September 20, 2007

Features of the new hospital:

- Improved layout allows greater coordination of services;
- Sterile processing department increases safety for patients and staff;
- Community health services available before discharge;
- Therapies and other treatments are offered in purpose-built spaces;
- Brighter spaces with prairie views;
- More private rooms, no large wards;
- Separate emergency room entrance and weather-protected ambulance bay;
- Digital diagnostic imaging, ready for coming digital archiving system;
- Improved energy efficiency and patient convenience.
