

Backgrounder

Humboldt Area Infrastructure Projects - Municipal Rural Infrastructure Fund (MRIF)

Village of St. Brieux–Water Reservoir Expansion

MRIF funding: \$110,050; Project cost: \$220,100

This project involves increasing the water reservoir's capacity to make more water available to the community. A well pump controller will also be replaced as part of this project. The larger water supply will also ensure that the Village has a consistent supply of water for fire hydrants in the case of an emergency.

Town of Wakaw–Sewer System Upgrade

MRIF funding: \$214,000; Project cost: \$428,000

This project involves replacing the existing sewer lift station with a new dry cell lift station to reduce the likelihood of sewer backup problems. It is also expected to help the Town of Wakaw develop its canal project, which could see up to 200 new homes built.

R.M. of Humboldt–Water Line Upgrade

MRIF funding: \$25,816; Project cost: \$51,635

The municipality will upgrade its water line valves and install 700 metres of new pipeline inside of its existing pipeline.

Total MRIF funding: \$349,866

Total project costs: \$699,735
