Building Canada in Saskatchewan

The Canada-Saskatchewan Building Canada Framework Agreement outlines the Government of Canada's commitment to provide funding of **\$635 million** to Saskatchewan over seven years, through three different programs:

1. **Building Canada Fund** - \$236 million over seven years - consisting of:
 - \$94.5 million through the Communities Component for communities of less than 100,000 people (to be matched by the Province)
 - \$141.5 million through the Major Infrastructure Component, for projects of provincial, regional or national significance (to be matched on a project-by-project basis by partners, including provincial governments, local governments and the private sector)
 2. **Provincial/Territorial Base Fund** - \$175 million over seven years; and,
 3. **Gas Tax Fund** – approximately \$224 million through the extension of the Gas Tax Agreement, bringing the total to more than \$336 million over seven years between 2007-2014.
- Saskatchewan infrastructure initiatives in eligible categories may have the opportunity to benefit from the Public-Private Partnership Fund and the Gateways and Border Crossings Fund.
 - Saskatchewan communities continue to receive funding under the current Gas Tax Fund Agreement (2005-2010).
