

Backgrounder

The AgriStability Program

- AgriStability is a federal-provincial risk management program for agriculture producers. AgriStability recently replaced the Canadian Agricultural Income Stabilization (CAIS) program.
- AgriStability is currently delivered *federally* for British Columbia, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Yukon, Newfoundland and Labrador.
- AgriStability is currently delivered *provincially* in Alberta, Ontario, Quebec and Prince Edward Island.

Saskatchewan Crop Insurance

- Saskatchewan Crop Insurance currently offers multi-peril insurance for natural perils on a variety of crops.
- The program is administered out of its head office in Melville with 21 customer service offices located throughout the province.
- The Corporation currently has more than 400 permanent and part-time employees province-wide with 100 staff located in Melville.
- This move will result in approximately 110 new jobs at the Saskatchewan Crop Insurance Corporation head office in Melville, and 30 new jobs at Crop Insurance offices throughout rural Saskatchewan.
