

Backgrounder

- Saskatchewan Crop Insurance Corporation (SCIC) will begin processing the final benefits for the 2009 program year January 1, 2010 and will take over all program processes for the 2010 program year.

- For AgriStability inquiries regarding 2008 and previous program years, as well as 2009 fee payments, interim payments, and targeted advance payments, producers should continue to contact Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada at 1-866-367-8506.
- The administration of AgriStability will result in 110 new jobs at SCIC head office and 30 new jobs throughout rural Saskatchewan. The hiring process is already underway.
- SCIC administers the Crop Insurance and Wildlife Damage Compensation programs from its head office in Melville and 21 customer service offices across the province.
