

## **BACKGROUNDER**

- Deadline extension for seeding greenfeed crops: The deadline has been extended from June 30 to July 15 for seeding annual cereal crops grown for greenfeed, including wheat, barley, oats, triticale, fall and spring rye.
- Producers who have Crop Insurance can now seed and insure any cereal greenfeed crop.
- Payments without inspections in areas impacted by severe drought: In areas severely affected by drought, an increased number of producers will have their claims processed without field inspection in order to receive their payments faster.
- If necessary, Saskatchewan Crop Insurance will move adjusters to areas where additional resources are required.
- Crop Insurance customers can graze their forage or annual crops or cut their annual crops for feed. A claim payment is issued based on an adjuster appraising the yield of the selected acres. Customers should contact Crop Insurance prior to grazing or cutting crops.
