Prioritized risk groups, H1N1

H1N1 has been in Saskatchewan since April of this year, and a good deal is known now regarding groups it affects the most. Based on science around the world, Saskatchewan has rolled out its vaccine clinics based on these priorities to date:

1. Health care workers
2. People in remote and isolated communities
3. Pregnant women and post-partum up to four weeks
4. Children from six months to less than five years
5. Children from Kindergarten to Grade Six inclusive

As the vaccine becomes more available, the next priority groups for vaccination will be announced.
