

Backgrounder – Reallocation of Wood Volumes from the Prince Albert Forest Management Agreement

The Prince Albert Forest Management Agreement (FMA) comprises approximately 3.3 million hectares in area and is located in north central Saskatchewan. It is currently managed by Domtar and held in the name of Weyerhaeuser.

Companies, First Nations, and communities that will receive wood allocations from the FMA once consultations are concluded with area First Nations are as follows:

The remaining 200,000 cubic metres of softwood saw log volume will be reserved for 18 months, to allow for consideration of new proposals by companies and forest communities.
