
Background

IMPROVING INFRASTRUCTURE IN SASKATOON

Infrastructure investment stimulates economic growth, creates jobs, supports stronger communities and enhances the overall prosperity of residents of Saskatchewan.

The Destination Centre will provide the following benefits for residents and visitors to the region:

- Exhibition galleries;
- Education and public programs space;
- Collection and preparation space;
- A winter haven for River Landing visitors;
- An atrium, reception area and information kiosk.

The Government of Canada is setting aside up to one-third of eligible costs, to a maximum federal contribution of \$13.02 million for this project. The Government of Saskatchewan is also providing \$13.02 million for this project. The City of Saskatoon and other key partners have committed funding in support of this project. The total estimated costs for the Centre will be approximately \$51 million.

Federal funding for this project will come from the Building Canada Fund – Major Infrastructure Component.

Federal financial support for this project is conditional on the project meeting all applicable eligibility and approval requirements under the Government of Canada's infrastructure plan and on the signing of a contribution agreement.
