Building Pride
Fall 2009 Adjudication**

Applicants receiving funding under Building Pride:

1. Frenchman Butte Historical Society is receiving \$5,000 for the Steele's Scouts Commemorative Cavalry to commemorate the 125th anniversary of the 1885 North West Resistance;
2. Friends of the Regina Public Library is receiving \$8,100 for the commemoration of the 100th anniversary of the Regina Public Library;
3. The Indigenous Peoples Program is receiving \$10,000 for a special event to celebrate the cultural achievements of First Nations and Métis youth;
4. Jasper Culture and Historical Centre will receive \$16,000 to celebrate the centennial of the Jasper Cultural and Historical Centre Building;
5. The Kelstern Community Church Anniversary Committee will receive \$2,000 for the centennial of the Kelstern Community Church;
6. The Lobstick Golf Club Inc., a non-profit corporation that operates the Waskesiu Golf Course, will receive \$22,000 for a legacy project to celebrate the 75th anniversary of the Waskesiu Golf Course;
