Rennie Harper, Nipawin Vice-Chairperson

Rennie Harper has been employed in the health care system for 20 years and is currently a surveyor for Accreditation Canada assessing health care organizations across the country, as well as self-employed as a Health Planning Consultant. Rennie held several positions in the Saskatchewan health system, most recently as Vice-President, Operations Support with the Kelsey Trail Health Region. A long-time resident of Nipawin, Harper immigrated to Saskatoon from Germany as a child. She earned a Bachelor of Social Work degree from the University of Regina. She has served on the executive of a number of community and professional associations, including as Past President of the Nipawin District Chamber of Commerce. Most recently Harper has served as chairperson of the North East Health Services Committee.

Clarence Hendrickson, Carrot River

Clarence Henderson retired in 2000, after working for 33 years in increasingly senior executive positions at Carrot River Health Care Authority, Carrot River Housing Authority and the North-East Health District.
