

RN/RPN Progress Toward Hiring Targets 2008 – 2010 By Paid Straight Time FTEs

The following charts show the increased number of full time equivalent (FTE) nursing positions and the number of nursing vacancies within Saskatchewan and by regional health authorities.

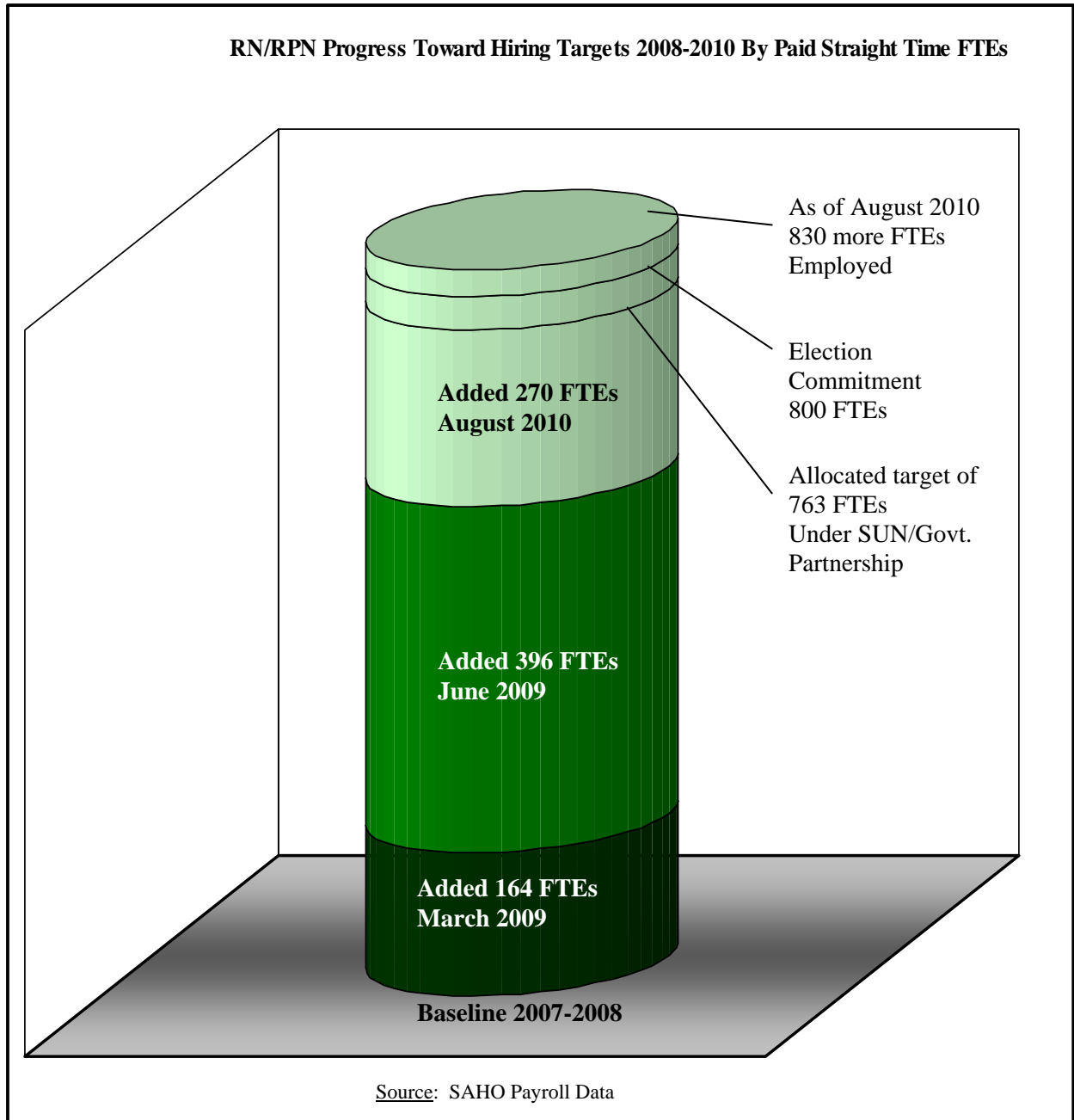
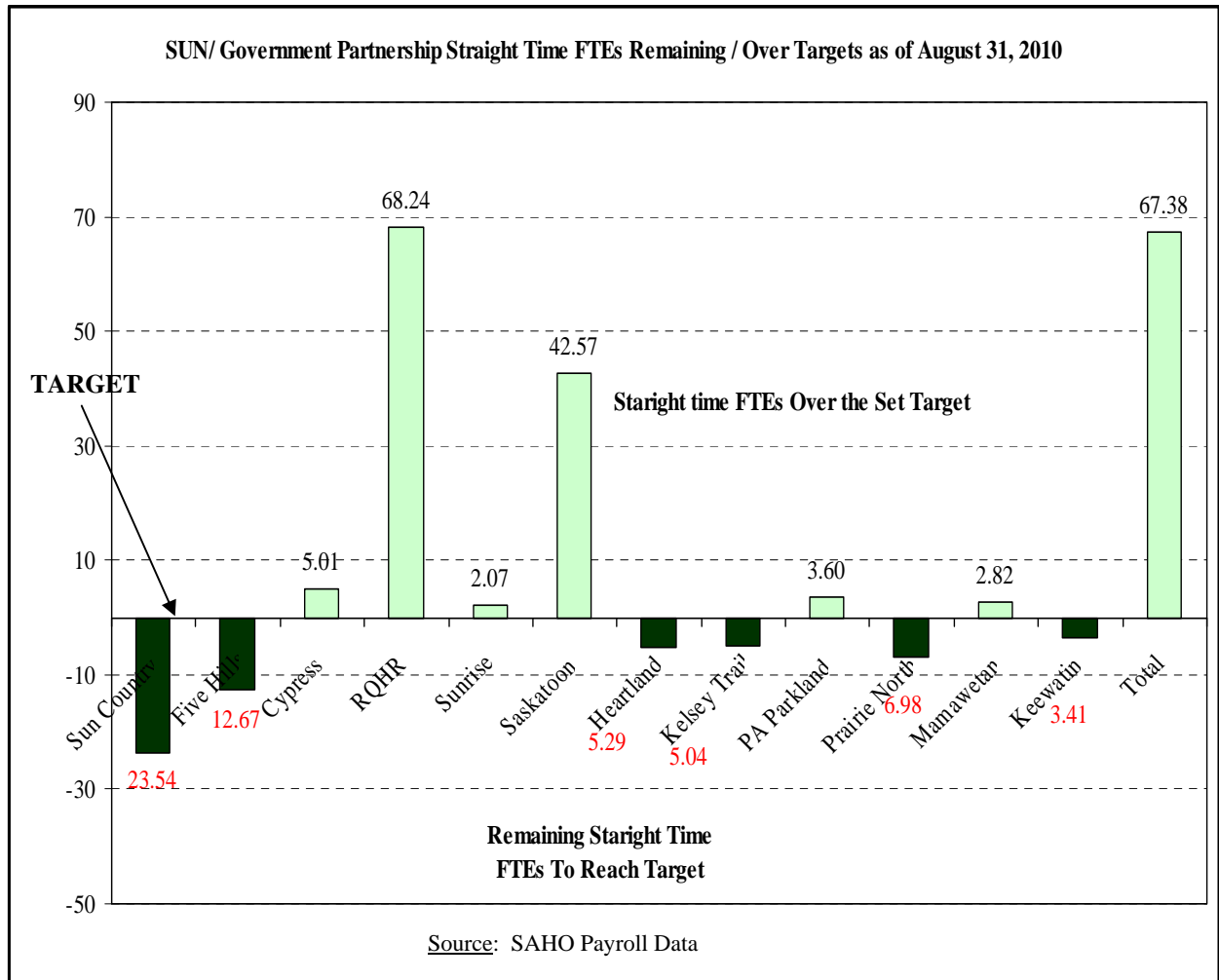

One of the processes used under the Partnership was to allocate FTEs to each of the 12 health regions. They were each given a target to work towards. To date, we have allocated 763 of the 800 FTEs and health regions have filled 706 of those 763 FTEs. Six of the health regions have 57 FTEs remaining to meet their target. The other six health regions have surpassed their initial target by 124 FTEs. The net result is 67.38 FTEs in excess of the targets currently set.

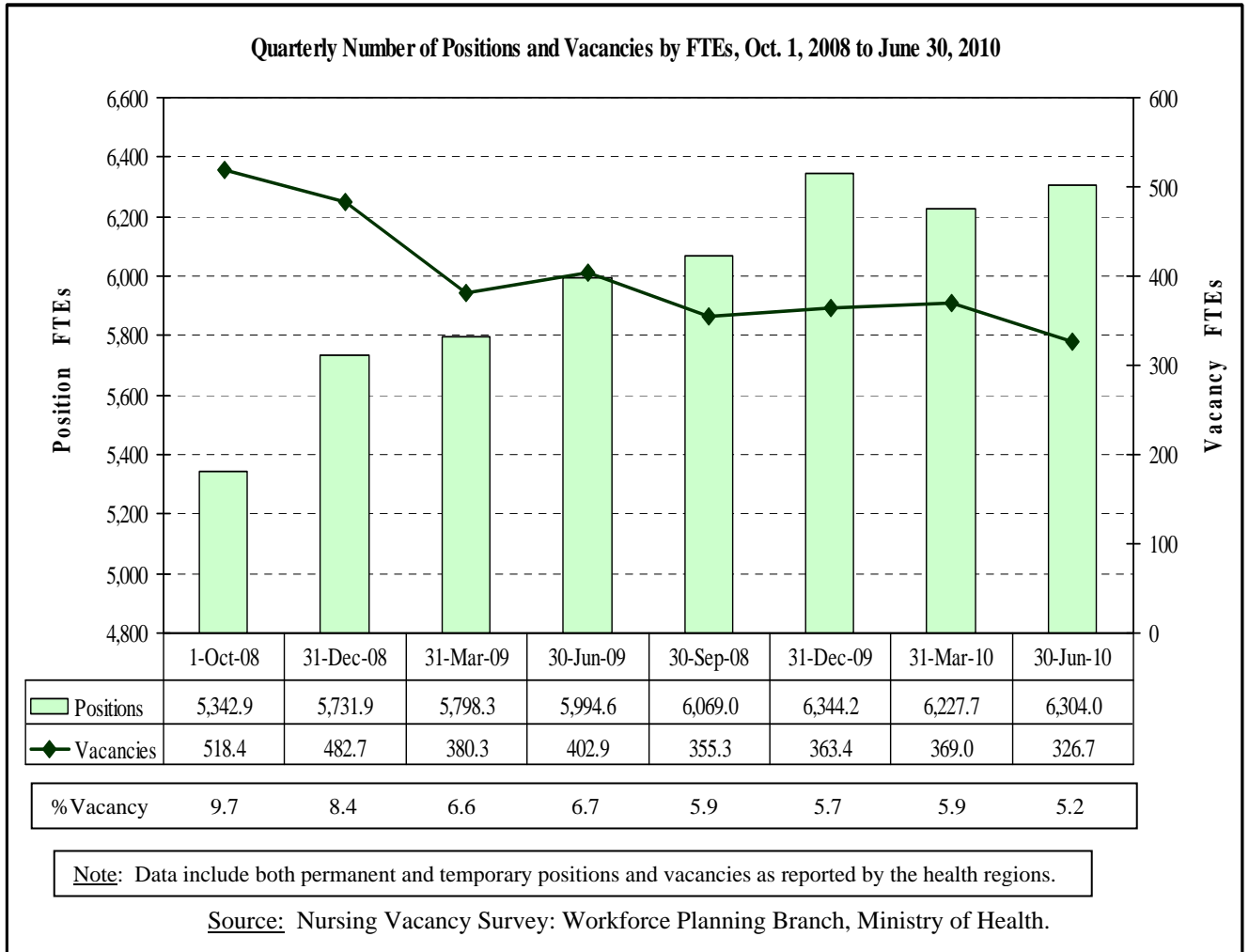


Chart 3 shows the number of nursing positions and vacancies by FTEs since October 1, 2008 as reported by the health regions. It also shows the percentage vacancies for each quarter for the period October 1, 2008 and June 30, 2010.
