

Qualified Independent School Criteria

The Ministry of Education will provide 50% of the provincial per student average for All registered Qualified Independent Schools that meet the specific criteria to qualify for funding.

The criteria are as follows:

- employ only certified Saskatchewan Professional “A” teachers;
- teach the Saskatchewan curriculum;
- operate as an incorporated non-profit organization;
- apply to Saskatchewan resident students only;
- participate in the provincial accountability framework
- submit financial statements prepared in accordance with *The Non-Profit Corporations Act, 1995*;
- have been in operation for a minimum of two consecutive years;
- facilitate inspection and supervision by Ministry officials or their designates; and,
- comply with Ministry policy and directives.

Associate School Funding

Funding for associate schools will be provided to school divisions at 80% of the provincial average per-student amount. Associate schools will not be eligible for any additional provincial funding, including capital.
