Memorandum of Understanding between the Government of Saskatchewan and Gujarat Minerals Development Corporation

Under the MOU, the Government of Saskatchewan and the Gujarat Minerals Development Corporation agree to cooperate in investment related to mineral exploration and development activities. The MOU identifies specific target areas for cooperation: lignite and subbituminous coal and coal-to-liquids technologies; potash, silica sands, and clays; diamonds, base metals, and rare earth elements; oil and natural gas; and, carbon capture & sequestration and enhanced oil recovery technologies. It also calls for an exchange of visitors in order to evaluate interests identified in the MOU.

Memorandum of Understanding between the Province of Saskatchewan and the State of Gujarat

The MOU is intended as a significant step toward establishing long-term relations with one of the most important and dynamic Indian states. Under the MOU, Saskatchewan and Gujarat agree to exchange professional knowledge and expertise in natural resources; promote natural resources fairs and expos in each other's jurisdictions; and exchange professional knowledge and expertise in mineral exploration techniques. A Saskatchewan-Gujarat Forum for Cooperation will be established that will have a presence in both Saskatchewan and Gujarat in order to help implement the MOU.

Memorandum of Understanding between the Province of Saskatchewan and the Indian Ministry of Agriculture

Under the MOU, Saskatchewan and the Indian Ministry of Agriculture will exchange professional knowledge and expertise in crop production, post-harvest management, food processing, and agri-business development and management. They also agree to promote and market agricultural products and cooperate on agricultural technology transfer. A coordinating committee will be established to oversee the implementation of the agreement.

Memorandum of Understanding between the Province of Saskatchewan and the Indian Ministry of Mines

Under the MOU, Saskatchewan and the Indian Mines Ministry will promote investment in mining and mining-related activities, mineral exploration, and development. The MOU will also encourage and foster mining investment, transfers of technology in areas of interest, and joint ventures in India and Saskatchewan. A Joint Working Group will be established to identify opportunities, plan, and coordinate the implementation of the areas of cooperation under the MOU. The Ministry of Energy and Resources will be the lead ministry for Saskatchewan.

MOUs to be acknowledged/witnessed by the Premier:

SIAST and Charutar Vidya Mandal College

The MOU will allow SIAST and the Charutar Vidya Mandal (CVM), an educational foundation in India, to deliver the SIAST CAD/CAM Engineering Technology Diploma and the Business Administration Diploma Programs at the CVM campus in India. SIAST diploma programs in English will begin in September 2011 and will be delivered by CVM instructors at CVM facilities to fee-paying students, with SIAST responsible for curricula, instructor guides, ongoing support and program certification.

Memorandum of Understanding between the Saskatchewan Pulse Growers (SPG) and the Indian Institute of Crop Processing Technology (IICPT)

The Saskatchewan Pulse Growers (SPG) and Indian Institute of Crop Processing Technology (IICPT) signed an MOU that will result in further collaboration to increase the market for Saskatchewan pulse crops in India. SPG and IICPT will conduct joint research to identify new Indian foods made of SK pulses and improve food storage technologies in India.

Bangladesh MOUs

Memorandum of Understanding between the Government of Saskatchewan and the Government of Bangladesh

Under this MUU, Saskatchewan and Bangladesh will collaborate to improve the technical and vocational training capacity of Bangladesh, facilitate cooperation in higher education and research among post-secondary education institutions, and promote trade in agri-food products between the two jurisdictions.

MOUs to be acknowledged/witnessed by the Premier:

Memorandum of Understanding between the University of Dhaka and the University of Saskatchewan: Biofortification MOU

The MOU will facilitate cooperation between the University of Saskatchewan and the University of Dhaka in higher education and research primarily aimed at pulse crop research and development. Under the MOU, the Government of Saskatchewan and the Saskatchewan Pulse Growers will contribute \$800,000 towards biotechnology research that would enhance the nutritional quality of lentils—one of the main export products from Saskatchewan to Bangladesh.

Memorandum of Understanding between Bangladesh Agricultural University and the University of Saskatchewan

Under this MoU, the University of Saskatchewan and Bangladesh Agricultural University will facilitate collaborative research in the areas of natural sciences, agriculture and agricultural engineering, as well as cooperation in faculty and student exchange programs.

Memorandum of Understanding between Khulna University and the University of Saskatchewan

Under this MOU, the University of Saskatchewan and Khulna University will facilitate cooperation in computer science training and research. The cooperation would include student and faculty exchanges, internships, and academic supervision at senior undergraduate and graduate levels.

Memorandum of Understanding between the Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology, and the College of Engineering, University of Saskatchewan

Under this MOU, the University of Saskatchewan's College of Engineering and the Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology will cooperate in enhancing engineering education and research, organizing seminars and conferences in the areas of mutual interests. The MOU also contemplates student and faculty exchanges.

Memorandum of Understanding between the Trading Corporation of Bangladesh (TCB) and Saskatchewan Trade and Export Partnership (STEP)

This MOU will help these two trade organizations enhance commercial relationships between them. Under this MoU, STEP will have access to trade information and intelligence from the TCB, which is a major procuring agency of agri-food products in Bangladesh. Saskatchewan's pulses and other agri-food exporters, who are members of STEP, are expected to benefit from this MoU.

Memorandum of Understanding between the Gujarat Chamber of Commerce and Industry and the Regina & District Chamber of Commerce

This MOU will enhance cooperation between the Gujarat Chamber of Commerce and Industry (GCCCI) and the Regina & District Chamber of Commerce (RCC) to create increased trade and investment opportunities for the Gujarati and Canadian companies in both countries and respective states. The GCCCI and RCC will work in close collaboration to achieve these goals and to enhance the liaison and cooperation between the respective organizations in the areas of economic development in key sectors including, but not limited to, Import-Export, Investment, Taxation, Business Information, Immigration and Government policies and other commerce-oriented activities to the exclusive benefit of the members of both the organizations.
