



WEEKLY PROVINCIAL HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE FOR WED., Aug. 1, 2012
Slow to 60 km/hr when passing workers and equipment

NEW WORK

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 2 near St. Louis (Bridge work)

ESTIMATED COST: \$35,000

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 30, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Repairs to bridge deck on Highway 2 near Village of St. Louis

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Lane closures at times, traffic being re-routed to centre lane, watch for signs and directions, use caution and reduce speed

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of August 6, 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 4 near Rosetown

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 30, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Patching and full seal on Highway 4 north of the junction of Highway 31

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Flag persons, fresh oil, loose stones, one lane traffic, dust

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of August 6, 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 4 (Bridge work)

ESTIMATED COST: \$1.2 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 2, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Replacement of a 27-metre-long bridge crossing over Denniel Creek about 17 km north of the Highway 18 junction

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Temporary bridge, one lane traffic, obey flagpersons, reduce speed

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of August 20, 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 5 near Saskatoon

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 30, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Patching on Highway 5 between the junction of Highway 2 and the City of Saskatoon

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane, obey flag persons, expect delays, loose stones and fresh oil

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of August 6, 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 13 near Trossachs

ESTIMATED COST: \$700,000

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 30, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Culvert installation under Highway 13 approximately 1 km east of its junction with Highway 28

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Motorists should be aware of construction equipment and workers

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Mid August 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 18 near Mankota (Bridge work)

ESTIMATED COST: \$900,000

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 30, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Replacement of an 18-metre-long bridge over McDonald Creek on Highway 18 near Mankota

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic will be reduced to one lane, obey flag persons

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of September 10, 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 31 near Macklin

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 30, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Patching and full seal on Highway 31 between Salvador and Primate and patching of the Herschel Access road

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Flag persons, fresh oil, loose stones, one lane traffic, dust

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of August 6, 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 41 near Melfort

ESTIMATED COST: \$35,000

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 30, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Crack repairs on Highway 41 near Melfort

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic reduced to one lane, flag persons present, reduced speeds, watch for equipment and workers

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of August 6, 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 42 near Lucky Lake

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 30, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Patching and spot sealing on Highway 42 and on the Demaine Access road

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Flag persons, fresh oil, loose stones, one lane traffic

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of August 6, 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 55 near Nipawin

ESTIMATED COST: \$5.3 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 30, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 18 km of repaving from Tindall Avenue in Nipawin to southeast of Love

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane through the work area

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 342 near Eston

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 30, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Patching and seal on Highway 342 between Lacadena and the Highway 44 junction

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Flag persons, fresh oil, loose stones, one lane traffic

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Mid August, 2012

ONGOING WORK

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 1 at White City

ESTIMATED COST: \$2.5 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 16, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Construction of an exit ramp (eastbound on Highway 1 to southbound on Highway 48), entrance ramp (northbound on Highway 48 to eastbound on Highway 1) and service road at the junction of Highways 1 and 48 at White City

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Watch for trucks turning on and off Highway 48, reduce speed in construction zone, traffic may be reduced to one lane through work zone

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Mid September 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 1 near Indian Head

ESTIMATED COST: \$4.5 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of June 18, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 17 km of paving along Highway 1 from about 4 km east of the junction with Highway 56 to east junction of Highway 35

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane, obey flag people and expect minor delays

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 2 near Hoey

ESTIMATED COST: \$7.6 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of April 30, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Grading of about 8.6 km from about 10 km south of its junction with Highway 25 to the north and grading of about 1.1 km of a new access road to Hoey (work will take place along about 1 km of existing Highway 2 with the remainder of the work taking place along existing municipal roads)

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane, be aware of potential blowing dust

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highways 2 and 25 near St. Louis

ESTIMATED COST: \$4.4 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of June 18, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Grading of Highways 2 and 25 south and east of their junction, about 1.7 km of grading on the access road to St. Louis and work on Highway 2 south of the abutment to a new bridge and north of Highway 25

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane on Highway 25 and the access road to St. Louis, be aware of potential blowing dust

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 4 near Saskatchewan Landing Bridge

ESTIMATED COST: \$2.1 million (surfacing portion)

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of April 23, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Surface work resumes on about a 5 km truck climbing lane, truck pull-out and a passing lane south of the Saskatchewan Landing Provincial Park

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Expect delays and disruptions, obey flag persons and pilot vehicle, be cautious and alert

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Mid August 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 5 near of Quill Lake

ESTIMATED COST: \$3.1 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 23, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 15 km of paving on Highway 5 from Quill Lake to east of Watson

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic reduced to one lane, obey flag people and expect minor delays

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Late August 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 10 near Balcarres

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of June 11, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Culvert work and repairs to side slope on Highway 10 about 7 km west of Balcarres

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Watch for trucks turning onto and off Highway 10

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: End of August 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 11 from Regina to Bethune

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of June 11, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Paving of Highway 11 northbound lanes from Regina to Lumsden and southbound lanes from Bethune to Disley and from the weigh scales to junction of Highway 6 (includes paving of various ramps and bridges)

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic will be reduced to one lane, expect delays, exit ramps may be closed during paving

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: End of August 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 11 near Kenaston

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week July 23, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Patching on Highway 11 between Bladworth and Kenaston, northbound lanes only

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane, obey flag person, expect delays, loose stones and fresh oil

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of August 6, 2012

Highway 11 twinning between Prince Albert and Saskatoon

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 11 near Macdowall

ESTIMATED COST: \$6 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of May 28, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 13 km of grading work on new northbound lanes from 2.5 km south of Macdowall northeast (part of Highway 11 twinning between Prince Albert and Saskatoon)

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Motorists should be aware of blowing dust

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 11 from north of Duck Lake to south of Macdowall

ESTIMATED COST: \$11.4 million (paving only)

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 19 km of paving work on new northbound lanes from north of Duck Lake to south of Macdowall (part of Highway 11 twinning between Prince Albert and Saskatoon)

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Motorists should be aware of blowing dust and be cautious in the area

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 11 from north of Rosthern to south of Duck Lake

ESTIMATED COST: \$12.6 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 23, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 9 km of work consisting of applying and compacting gravel and sand, followed by the paving of new northbound lanes from north of Rosthern to south of Duck Lake (part of Highway 11 twinning between Prince Albert and Saskatoon)

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Motorists should be aware of blowing dust

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 13 near Verwood

ESTIMATED COST: \$7.6 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of May 14, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 20 km of widening and paving on Highway 13 east of Verwood

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: End of August 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 14 near Wilkie

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of June 4, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Patching on Highway 14 between Asquith and Perdue

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Expect minor delays, obey flag people, fresh oil and loose stones

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 15 near Ituna

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of June 4, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Installation of a culvert under Highway 15 between Goodeve and Ituna with spot sealing and patching between Ituna and the junction of Highway 6

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane, expect minor delays and obey flag people

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 15 near Milden

ESTIMATED COST: \$7.7 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of May 14, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 16.5 km of widening and repaving from about the junction with Highway 42 to Sovereign

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 18 near Val Marie (Bridge replacement over Frenchman River)

ESTIMATED COST: \$800,000

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 16, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Replacing existing bridge and paving of the bridge 1 km east of Val Marie over the Frenchman River on Highway 18

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Temporary bridge, one lane traffic, obey flagpersons, reduce speed

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of August 6, 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 23 near Porcupine Plain

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of June 4, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Spot sealing on Highway 23 continues between Somme to the Junction of Highway 38

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Expect delays, fresh oil

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 27 near Prud'homme

ESTIMATED COST: \$3.8 million (grading portion only)

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of April 16, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Grading of about 8 km from the junction with Highway 2 to Prud'homme (paving to follow)

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane, motorists should be aware of potential blowing dust

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 27 near Vonda

ESTIMATED COST: \$5 million (grading portion only)

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 16, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Grading of about 15 km from Prud'homme to Vonda (paving project to follow)

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane through the work area and motorists should be aware of potential blowing dust

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2013

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 39 near Halbrite

ESTIMATED COST: \$4.2 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 18, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 13.5 km of paving along Highway 39 From near Grid No. 705 to about 14 km northwest

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane, obey flag persons and expect minor delays

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Mid August 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 42 near Eyebrow

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 3, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Surfacing mixing and sealing of Highway 42 from Keeler to Eyebrow

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Expect delays, traffic reduced to one lane, obey flag people

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Mid August 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 42 near Dinsmore

ESTIMATED COST: \$1.8 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of May 28, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Grading and paving at Dinsmore from near junction of Highway 44 to about 1.5 km west of its junction with Highway 44, patching and spot sealing along Highways 342 and 42 near Beechy to Dinsmore

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be restricted to one lane, fresh oil, loose stones, and blowing dust

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 48 near Kipling

ESTIMATED COST: \$17.7 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 2, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 25 km of grading, paving and widening of shoulders on Highway 48 between Kipling and the junction of Highway 9 east of Kennedy

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane, obey flag people

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2013

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 51 near Major

ESTIMATED COST: \$1 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of April 23, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Grading work continues at Major and heading west for about 4 km (part of a multi-year partnership project)

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic will be reduced to one lane, obey flag people and watch for loose stones

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 55 near Saskatchewan-Alberta border

ESTIMATED COST: \$18.2 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of May 7, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 26 km of grading and paving on Highway 55 from the Alberta-Saskatchewan border to about 10 km east of Pierceland

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Allow for extra travel time, traffic may be reduced to one lane, be aware of potential blowing dust, watch for soft portions and fresh gravel

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 55 near Red Earth

ESTIMATED COST: \$4.1 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of May 14, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 17 km of construction is now taking place on Highway 55 from about 10 km east of its junction with the Red Earth access road to about 7 km west of the junction, work will include the placement of sand and gravel over the existing surface (upon completion, motorists will travel on an upgraded, dust-free surface)

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic will potentially be reduced to one lane through the area

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Red Earth Access Road near Highway 55

ESTIMATED COST: \$4.4 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of May 14, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 14 km of construction is now taking place on the Red Earth Access Road from its junction with Highway 55 to the north, work will include the placement of sand and gravel over the existing surface (upon completion, motorists will travel on an upgraded, dust-free surface)

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane through the work area

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 55 near Shoal Lake

ESTIMATED COST: \$5.4 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 16, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 12 km of construction on Highway 55 from its junction with the Shoal Lake access road to the southwest, work will include the widening of the existing road shoulders and placement of sand and gravel over the widened road surface (motorists will travel on an upgraded, dust-free surface after the work is completed)

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic will potentially be reduced to one lane through the work area

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: 2013

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 55 bridge near Red Earth and Shoal Lake

ESTIMATED COST: \$30,000

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 16, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Minor repairs on several bridges in the area

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic reduced to one lane at times, yield to oncoming traffic, be cautious

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 56 near Indian Head

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 9, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Culvert installation under Highway 56 about 11 km north of Indian Head

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Motorists should be aware of equipment and workers

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Mid August 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 57 near the Saskatchewan-Manitoba border

ESTIMATED COST: \$1 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 16, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 4 km of paving on Highway 57 from the Saskatchewan-Manitoba border to the junction of Highway 5

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic reduced to one lane, obey flag people and expect minor delays

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Mid August 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 310 between Foam Lake and Kuroki

ESTIMATED COST: \$21 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: April 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 29 km of grading and paving work from 1 km north of its junction with Highway 16 to its junction with Highway 5

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Obey flag people, expect minor delays, fresh oil and loose stones, rough areas and blowing dust

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Mid September 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 310 between Ituna and Foam Lake

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: April 2012

DESCRIPTION: Blading of the gravel section ongoing

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Watch for equipment, be aware of ridges on the road, loose stones

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Mid August 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 335 near Leather River

ESTIMATED COST: \$5.2 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of November 28, 2011

DESCRIPTION: Construction of a steel and concrete bridge on Highway 335 over the Leather River and

construction of a 1 km long sub-grade and a surfacing structure on Highway 335 from about 7 km east to about 6 km east of its junction with Highway 35

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic will be detoured around construction

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of August 27, 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 342 near Clearwater Lake

ESTIMATED COST: \$1.1 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 2012

DESCRIPTION: Grading work followed by double seal coat about 2 km east of Clearwater Lake access for about 7 km

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic will be reduced to one lane, obey flag people

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 349 near Archerwill

ESTIMATED COST: \$1.1 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of May 28, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Construction of a new 24-metre-long precast concrete bridge on Highway 349 over Red Deer River about 11 km east of Archerwill

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane while bridge is being paved

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Late August 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 365 north of Manitou Beach

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of May 14, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Blading continues on gravel section of Highway 365 between Manitou Beach and Plunkett

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Expect minor delays, watch for equipment

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 368 south of St. Brieux

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of May 14, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Patching and spot sealing continues on Highway 368 between the "Pleasantdale Grid" and just south of St. Brieux

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Expect minor delays, fresh oil and loose stones

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 368 south of St. Brieux

ESTIMATED COST: \$15.7 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of June 11, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 25 km of paving between Lake Lenore to 5 km south of St. Brieux to complete a 35 km upgrade worth \$21 million (about 10 km completed in 2009 between Grid 756 and Lake Lenore)

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Potential for equipment and workers in the ditch

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 953 near Anglin Lake

ESTIMATED COST: \$4.3 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of June 11, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 11.5 km of work from the junction of Highways 953 and 2 to the southwest, includes widening, along with the placement of sand and gravel over the existing surface (upon completion, motorists will travel on an upgraded, dust-free surface), nearly 2 km of similar work (except widening) will also occur on roads in the Anderson Point Campground

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 962 near Uranium City, culvert replacement

ESTIMATED COST: \$535,000

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 16

DESCRIPTION: Replacement of existing culvert under Highway 962 with new steel culverts about 5 km southwest of Uranium City

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic will be detoured around construction

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Mid August 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Dalmeny Access Road near Highway 16

ESTIMATED COST: \$20.3 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of June 4, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 13.5 km of road widening and surfacing on Dalmeny Access between Town of Dalmeny and about 2 km south of the junction of Highway 16

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Minor traffic delays and disruptions, be cautious and alert, be aware of blowing dust and equipment in the area

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Spring 2013

PROJECT/WORK: Gerald Access Road off Highway 22

ESTIMATED COST: \$775,000

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 23, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Shoulder widening followed by milling of existing pavement, then laying of gravel (base overlay) and paving of the entire 1.5-km long access road

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Local detour in effect

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Laird Access Road near Highway 312

ESTIMATED COST: \$2.1 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of June 11, 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 6 km of surfacing on the Laird Access Road between Highway 312 and Laird

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Motorists should reduce speeds and avoid shoulders, traffic may be reduced to one lane

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Leroy Access Road

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of May 28, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Patching and spot filling continues along Leroy Access Road south of Highway 5

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Loose stones, expect delays

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2012

PROJECT/WORK: Waldheim Access Road near Highway 312

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 23, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Patching through the Town of Waldheim

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Obey flag person, expect delays, loose stones and fresh oil

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of August 6, 2012

West Regina Bypass

PROJECT/WORK: West Regina Overpass (Highway 1 and Pinkie Road)

ESTIMATED COST: \$43 million

START: Week of June 4, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Work includes grading of the abutments, connecting of ramps and roadways and the bridge structure

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Temporary traffic lights at the junction of Highway 1 and Pinkie Road for duration of construction, reduce speed to 60 km/h on Highway 1, traffic may be reduced to one lane in both directions

ESTIMATED OPENING TO TRAFFIC: Fall 2013

PROJECT/WORK: West Regina Bypass Stage 2

ESTIMATED COST: \$42.5 million (Stage 2 grading work only)

START: Week of May 14, 2012

DESCRIPTION: Grading for a four-lane road connecting Trans-Canada Highway 1 to Dewdney Avenue in Regina and building embankments for new CP Rail overpass

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Temporary traffic lights at the junction of Highway 1 and Pinkie Road for duration of construction, slow to 60 km/h, traffic may be reduced to one lane in both directions

ESTIMATED/TARGETTED FULL OPENING TO TRAFFIC OF STAGE 2: 2013/14

PROJECT/WORK: Yorkton West Truck Route Project Phase 2 (Bypass connecting Highways 16 and 52)

ESTIMATED COST: \$4.1 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Late April 2012

DESCRIPTION: About 6 km of grading and paving work for the construction of a bypass highway connecting Highway 16 and Grain Miller Road to Highway 52 and the construction of turning lanes at the intersection of Highway 52 and the bypass highway

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Motorist should be alert of large equipment working in the area

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2012
