WEEKLY PROVINCIAL HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE FOR Thursday, August 20, 2015

The law is black and white. Slow to 60 km/hr in Work Zones. Fines triple when you are caught.

NEW WORK

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 6 near the Jct of Highway 22

ESTIMATED COST: \$566,750

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of August 17, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Construction of a drainage system and culvert section replacement along the southeast embankment of Highway 6, 13 km southwest from the junction of Highway 22.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic should be aware of construction adjacent to the roadway. Watch for persons and equipment working. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Beginning of September 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 6 south of Southey

ESTIMATED COST: \$250,000

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of August 17, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Seal Coating on Highway 6 from its junction with Highway 99 to 7.66 km south of its junction with Highway 99, as well as seal coating south of Southey on Highway 6 from its junction with Highway 22 to 11 km south of its junction with Highway 22.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic will be reduced to one lane through

the work area. Expect delays. Watch for equipment and people working. Prepare to slow down and beware of blowing dust.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: End of August 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 33 from Lajorde to Kronau

ESTIMATED COST: \$4.5 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of August 17, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Construction of a surfacing structure on Highway 33 from 2.54 km northwest of the Lajorde access to Grid 622 at Kronau for a total distance of 9.86 km.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic will be reduced to one lane through the work area. Expect delays. Watch for equipment and people working. Prepare to slow down and beware of blowing dust.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Mid-October 2015

ONGOING WORK

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 1 near Swift Current

ESTIMATED COST: \$5.6 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: August 20, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Repaving the westbound lanes of Highway 1 from the Swift Current east city limits to 1 km east of the junction of Highway 32 in the westbound lane and various auxiliary lanes for a total distance of about 15 km.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic can expect minor delays and disruptions to their normal travel schedules as one lane will be open most of the time for continuous flowing traffic.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: October 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 1 near Chaplin /Balgonie

ESTIMATED COST: \$1.16 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: August 3, 2015



DESCRIPTION: Seal coat on Highway 1 from its junction with Chaplin at Highway 19 for a distance of 13 km to the east as well as a seal coat on Highway 1 from its junction with Balgonie at Highway 46 for a distance of 18 km to the east.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic will be reduced to one lane through the work area. Expect delays. Watch for equipment and people working. Prepare to slow down and beware of blowing dust.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Late August 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 1 near Regina

ESTIMATED COST: \$5.17 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: August 4, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Repaying 15 km of westbound lanes and 9 km of eastbound lanes on Highway 1, west from the junction of Lewvan Drive, for a total distance of 21 km.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic can expect minor delays as one lane will be open most of the time for

continuous flowing traffic.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: End of August 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 1 Bridge near Belle Plaine

ESTIMATED COST: \$491,000

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: July 27, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Rehabilitation of an existing concrete bridge on Highway 1 over CP Rail approximately 40

km west of Regina.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: During construction, a local detour will be in place to accommodate traffic.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: October 2015

PROJECT: Highway 2 Bridge over Hay Meadow Creek

ESTIMATED COST: \$5.8 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: July 15, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Construction of a bridge on Highway 2 over Hay Meadow Creek approximately 11 km north of Rockglen.

north of Rockgien.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: This section of highway will be restricted to legal load limits and a 4.3 m wide

lane.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 3 near of Birch Hills

ESTIMATED COST: \$420,000

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: August 3, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Seal Coating on Highway 3 from its junction with Highway 25 to 10 km north of its

junction with Highway 25 near Birch Hills.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic will be reduced to one lane through the work area. Expect delays. Watch for equipment and people working. Prepare to slow down and beware of blowing dust.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: August 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 3 near Paradise Hill and Frenchman Butte

ESTIMATED COST: \$7.76 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: August 3, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Paving on Highway 3 from its junction with Highway 26 to 7.14 km west and on Highway 3 from west abutment of Deer Creek bridge to 13.77 km west of the west abutment of Deer Creek bridge for a total distance of 20.91 km.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: During construction, traffic may be reduced to one lane. Prepare to slow down and beware of blowing dust.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: September 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 6 Bridge near Highway 13

ESTIMATED COST: \$1.02 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: August 4, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Demolition of an existing bridge and construction of a precast concrete bridge over an

unnamed stream on Highway 6 approximately 7 km north of Highway 13.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic can expect minor delays. During construction, a temporary bridge

detour will be in place to accommodate traffic. Temporary traffic lights will be in place.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Mid-September 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 7 twinning near Vanscoy

ESTIMATED COST: \$10.4 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 26, 2015

DESCRIPTION: About 9 km of grading of Highway 7 from 4 km to 13 km west of its junction with

Highway 60.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Motorists should be aware of potential blowing dust.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2015

PROJECT: Highway 15 east of Kenaston

ESTIMATED COST: \$5.9 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 25, 2015

DESCRIPTION: About 14.5 km of grading of Highway 15 from 5 km west to 19.5 km west of its junction

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane through the work area. Motorists should be

aware of potential blowing dust and windrows.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2016

PROJECT: Bridge on Highway 16 over Milligan Creek

ESTIMATED COST: \$1.5 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: July 20, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Construction of a bridge on Highway 16 over Milligan Creek, approximately 250 metres

east of the junction with Highway 310.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced. Prepare to slow down to 40 km/hr and beware of

potential blowing dust.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: September 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 16 Overpass over Idylwyld in Saskatoon

ESTIMATED COST: \$2.7 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: June 22, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Bridge rehabilitation on Highway 16 westbound over Highway 11 approximately 0.45 km northwest of the junction with Highway 11 near Saskatoon.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane. Prepare to slow down and beware of potential blowing dust.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of October 15, 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 16 near Clavet

ESTIMATED COST: \$28.7 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 19, 2015

DESCRIPTION: About 19 km of grading work for the new twinned highway lanes from 1 km west of its

intersection with the Bradwell access to 9 km east of its junction with Highway 11.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Motorists should be aware of blowing dust and be cautious in the area.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 21 through Kerrobert and Highway 51 from Kerrobert to Major

ESTIMATED COST: \$21.4 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 6, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Paving on Highway 21 from its south junction with Highway 51 to about 1 km north. Paving on Highway 51 from its junction with Highways 21 and 31 to its junction with the Major access for a total distance of 35.6 km.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane. Prepare to slow down and beware of

blowing dust.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: End of August 2015 for Highway 51; Highway 21 is complete for this project

PROJECT: Highway 22, west of Killaly

ESTIMATED COST: \$1.8 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: June 30, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Paving Highway 22 from its junction with Highway 47 to about 3 km west of that

junction.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane. Prepare to slow down and beware of

blowing dust.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of August 24, 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 22 from Southey to Earl Grey

ESTIMATED COST: \$13.8 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 8, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Grading and paving of approximately 10 km of Highway 22 from 5 km west of Southey to

Earl Grey.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic will be reduced to one lane through the work area. Expect delays. Watch for equipment and people working. Motorists should be aware of the potential of blowing dust.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2015

PROJECT: Highway 39 Estevan Truck Bypass

ESTIMATED COST: \$20.8 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: April 15, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Paving the Estevan Truck Route from the intersection of Shand Road to 1.95 km

northwest of Rafferty Road and ancillary roadways, for a total distance of 17.77 km.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Speed may be reduced at junctions of the Estevan Truck Bypass and Highway

39 for roadwork adjacent to the roadway. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: October 30, 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 40 near Blaine Lake

ESTIMATED COST: \$3.03 million

START OF YEARS CONSTRUCTION: June 9, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Paving on Highway 40 from 7.02 km east of the junction of Highway 12 to 0.03 km east of the junction of Highway 12, for a total distance of 6.99 km.

IMPACT ON MOTRISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane. Beware of rough road conditions and

blowing dust. Watch for equipment and workers on the road.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: August 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 42 from Keeler to Eyebrow

ESTIMATED COST: \$10.3 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: July 15, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Grading of approximately 22.5 km of Highway 42 from 1.9 km northwest of Keeler to 200

m west of Eyebrow.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane. Beware of rough road conditions and

blowing dust. Watch for equipment and workers.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2016

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 43 from Highway 2 to Gravelbourg

ESTIMATED COST: \$16.5 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: April 21, 2015

DESCRIPTION: 38 km of paving on Highway 43 from Highway 2 to the east junction of Highway 58. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Expect minor delays and disruptions as one lane will be open most of the time

for continuous flowing traffic.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2015

PROJECT: Highway 51 east of Major

ESTIMATED COST: \$3.1 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 20, 2015

DESCRIPTION: About 10 km of grading of Highway 51 from 24.5 km west to 34.26 km west of its

junction of Highway 21.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane through the work area. Motorists should be aware of potential blowing dust and windrows.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of August 24, 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 263 near Christopher Lake

ESTIMATED COST: \$22.2 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 20, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Grading and paving on Highway 263 from its junction with Highway 2 to its junction with

Okema Beach Access Road, for a total distance of 13.29 km.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane. Beware of rough road conditions and

blowing dust. Watch for equipment and workers.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: July 2016

PROJECT: Highway 305 east of Dalmeny

ESTIMATED COST: \$12.5 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 19, 2015

DESCRIPTION: About 6.5 km of grading and paving on Highway 305 between its junctions with Highway

12 to its junction with the Dalmeny Access Road.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic should be prepared to slow down and may be reduced to one lane. Be

aware of rough road conditions.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: October 2015

PROJECT: Highway 358 Bridge over Wood Mountain Creek

ESTIMATED COST: \$5.8 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: July 7, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Construction of a bridge on Highway 358 over Wood Mountain Creek approximately 25km south of Limorick

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: This section of highway will be restricted to legal load limits and 4.3 m wide

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: August 2015PROJECT/WORK: Highway 918 Bridge Replacement near

Beauval

ESTIMATED COST: \$1.15 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: July 27, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Construction of short span bridge on Highway 918 over Pine River approximately 24 km

north of its junction with Highway 165 near Beauval.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: During construction, a temporary bridge as local detour will be in place to

accommodate traffic.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: September 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 980 Bridge replacement 80 km south of Armit

ESTIMATED COST: \$500,000

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: July 13, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Construction of a bridge on Highway 980 over an unnamed creek 80 km south of Armit. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Single lane local detour will be open for the duration of the project. Public

traffic can expect minor delays.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: End of August 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Stony Rapids Airport Rehab, Apron Expansion and Access Road near Stony Rapids

ESTIMATED COST: \$15.1 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: June 1, 2015

DESCRIPTION: 1.3 km of grading and paving on Highway 905; grading and paving on the runway,

taxiway, and apron; and rehabilitation of the airfield electrical system.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS/AIRTRAFFIC: Public traffic should not experience delays. Normal operation of

the airport will be temporarily impacted during construction.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: October 2015
