WEEKLY PROVINCIAL HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE FOR Thursday, July 23, 2015

The law is black and white. Slow to 60 km/hr in Work Zones. Fines triple when you are caught.

NEW WORK

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 1 Bridge near Belle Plaine

ESTIMATED COST: \$491,000 START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: July 27, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Rehabilitation of an existing concrete bridge on Highway 1 over CP Rail approximately 40 km west of Regina. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: During construction, a local detour will be in place to accommodate traffic. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: October 2015

PROJECT: Highway 2 Bridge over Hay Meadow Creek

ESTIMATED COST: \$5.8 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: July 15, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Construction of a bridge on Highway 2 over Hay Meadow Creek approximately 11 km north of Rockglen. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: This section of highway will be restricted to legal load limits and a 4.3 m wide lane. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2015



PROJECT: Bridge on Highway 16 over Milligan Creek

ESTIMATED COST: \$1.5 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: July 20, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Construction of a bridge on Highway 16 over Milligan Creek, approximately 250 metres east of the junction with Highway 310. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced, prepare to slow down to 40 km/h and beware of potential blowing dust. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 42 from Keeler to Eyebrow

ESTIMATED COST: \$10.3 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: July 15, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Grading of approximately 22.5 km of Highway 42 from 1.9 km northwest of Keeler to 200 metres west of Eyebrow. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane. Beware of rough road conditions and blowing dust. Watch for equipment and workers. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2016

ONGOING WORK

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 1 near Moosomin

ESTIMATED COST: \$2.25 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 13, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Application of a seal coat on 46.85 km of Highway 1 northwest of Moosomin. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic will be reduced to one lane through the work area. Expect delays. Watch for equipment and people working. Prepare to slow down and beware of blowing dust. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: August 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 1 near Belle Plaine

ESTIMATED COST: \$4.01 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: July 8, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Repaying the eastbound lanes of Highway 1 from 12.25 km east, to its junction with Highway 39 and the extension of a turning lane on Highway 1 at its junction with Grid Road 641 (Pense Access).

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic can expect minor delays and disruptions to their normal travel schedules as one lane will be open most of the time for continuous flowing traffic. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: July 31, 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 2/St. Louis Bridge

ESTIMATED COST: \$13.3 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of June 29, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Grading and paving north and south of the bridge, grading the Hoey access road, and repaving on Highway 25 near St. Louis.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: The road is closed and a detour is in place at tie-in of the existing Highway 2 with the new Highway 2 alignment at the south end. **ESTIMATED COMPLETION: August 2015**

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 3 Culverts installation near Spiritwood

ESTIMATED COST: \$301,000 START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: July 6, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Two culvert installations; one east of Spiritwood and one west of Spiritwood. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Motorists can expect minor delays and disruptions to their normal travel schedules as one lane will be open most of the time for continuous flowing traffic. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: August 2015

PROJECT: Highway 6 between Minton and Ceylon

ESTIMATED COST: \$2.68 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: July 12, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Repaying from 0.20 km north to 13.20 km north of Highway 18, and 3.83 km to 6.43 km south of 705 grid; and on the Gladmar Access to 2.02 km north; for a total distance of 17.62 km. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be restricted to one-lane traffic. Please obey signs and flag persons.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: August 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 6 and Highway 41A near Melfort

ESTIMATED COST: \$5.85 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: June 18, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Paving on Highway 6 from 11.72 km south to 0.81 km south of its junction with Highway 41; and on Highway 41A from its junction with Highway 41 north to its junction with Highway 3; for a total of 14.28 km. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Expect minor delays and disruptions to normal travel schedules as one lane will

be open most of the time.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: July 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 7 twinning near Vanscoy

ESTIMATED COST: \$10.4 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 26, 2015 DESCRIPTION: About 9 km of grading of Highway 7, from 4 km to 13 km west of its junction with Highway 60. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Motorists should be aware of potential blowing dust. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2015

PROJECT: Highway 14 south of Wilkie

ESTIMATED COST: \$7.14 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: June 2, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Paving Highway 14 from its junction with Highway 29 to 17 km south, and on Highway 29 from its junction with Highway 14 to 0.20 km north; and paving the bridge approaches on Highway 14 approximately 23 km west of its junction with Highway 29; for a total distance of approximately 17 km. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane, prepare to slow down and beware of blowing dust.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of July 27, 2015

PROJECT: Highway 15 east of Kenaston

ESTIMATED COST: \$5.9 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 25, 2015 DESCRIPTION: About 14.5 km of grading of Highway 15, from 5 km west to 19.5 km west of its junction of Highway 2. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane through the work area. Motorists should be aware of potential blowing dust and windrows. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Summer 2016

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 16 Overpass over Idylwyld in Saskatoon

ESTIMATED COST: \$2.7 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: June 22, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Bridge rehabilitation on Highway 16 westbound over Highway 11 approximately 0.45 km northwest of the junction with Highway 11, near Saskatoon. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane, prepare to slow down and beware of potential blowing dust. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of October 15, 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 16 near Clavet

ESTIMATED COST: \$28.7 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 19, 2015

DESCRIPTION: About 19 km of grading work for the new twinned highway lanes from 1 km west of its intersection with the Bradwell access to 9 km east of its junction with Highway 11.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Motorists should be aware of blowing dust and be cautious in the area. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 21 north of Kindersley

ESTIMATED COST: \$259,000

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 13, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Application of a seal coat on 14.75 km of Highway 21 south of its junction with Highway 31.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic will be reduced to one lane through the work area. Expect delays. Watch for equipment and people working. Prepare to slow down and beware of blowing dust. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: August 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 21 through Kerrobert and Highway 51 from Kerrobert to Major

ESTIMATED COST: \$21.4 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 6, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Paving on Highway 21 from its south junction with Highway 51 to about 1 km north. Paving on Highway 51 from its junction with Highways 21 and 31 to its junction with the Major access. A total distance of 35.6 km.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane, prepare to slow down and beware of blowing dust.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: End of August 2015 for Highway 51; Highway 21 is complete for this project.

PROJECT: Highway 22, west of Killaly

ESTIMATED COST: \$1.8 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: June 30, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Paving Highway 22 from its junction with Highway 47 to about 3 km west of that junction. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane, prepare to slow down and beware of blowing dust.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: July 30, 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 22 from Southey to Earl Grey

ESTIMATED COST: \$13.8 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 8, 2015

DESCRIPTION: Grading and paving of approximately 10 km of Highway 22 from 5 km west of Southey to Earl Grey.

IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic will be reduced to one lane through the work area. Expect delays. Watch for equipment and people working. Motorists should be aware of the potential of blowing dust. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2015

PROJECT: Highway 39 Estevan Truck Bypass

ESTIMATED COST: \$20.8 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: April 15, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Paving the Estevan Truck Route from the intersection of Shand Road to 1.95 km northwest of Rafferty Road and ancillary roadways; for a total distance of 17.77 km. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Speed may be reduced at junctions of the Estevan Truck Bypass and Highway 39 for roadwork adjacent to the roadway. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: October 30, 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 40 near Blaine Lake

ESTIMATED COST: \$3.03 million START OF YEARS CONSTRUCTION: June 9, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Paving on Highway 40 from 7.02 km east of the junction of Highway 12 to 0.03 km east of the junction of Highway 12; for a total distance of 6.99 km. IMPACT ON MOTRISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane. Beware of rough road conditions and blowing dust. Watch for equipment and workers on the road. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: August 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 43 from Highway 2 to Gravelbourg

ESTIMATED COST: \$16.5 million

START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: April 21, 2015 DESCRIPTION: 38 km of paving on Highway 43 from Highway 2 to the east junction of Highway 58. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Expect minor delays and disruptions as one lane will be open most of the time for continuous flowing traffic. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2015

PROJECT: Highway 51 east of Major

ESTIMATED COST: \$3.1 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 20, 2015 DESCRIPTION: About 10 km of grading of Highway 51, from 24.5 km west to 34.26 km west of its junction of Highway 21. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane through the work area. Motorists should be aware of potential blowing dust and windrows. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Mid-August 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Red Earth Access Road near Highway 55

ESTIMATED COST: \$4.4 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 24, 2015 DESCRIPTION: About 14 km of construction on the Red Earth Access Road from its junction with Highway 55 to the north. Work will include the placement of sand and gravel over the existing surface. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane through the work area. Expect delays. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Week of July 13, 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 58 near Lafleche

ESTIMATED COST: \$18.1 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: April 27, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Grading and paving Highway 13 at Lafleche to Highway 43 at Gravelbourg. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: Fall 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 263 near Christopher Lake

ESTIMATED COST: \$22.2 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 20, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Grading and paving on Highway 263, from its junction with Highway 2 to its junction with Okema Beach Access Road; for a total distance of 13.29 km. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic may be reduced to one lane. Beware of rough road conditions and blowing dust. Watch for equipment and workers. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: July 2016

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 302 east of Prince Albert near Weldon Ferry

ESTIMATED COST: \$6.2 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 19, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Grading and paving on Highway 302 from Weldon Ferry landing to 2.5 km northwest. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Watch for equipment and people working adjacent to the road. Most of the work is on a new alignment. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: July 2015

PROJECT: Highway 305 east of Dalmeny

ESTIMATED COST: \$12.5 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: May 19, 2015 DESCRIPTION: About 6.5 km of grading and paving on Highway 305 between its junctions with Highway 12 to its junction with the Dalmeny Access Road. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Traffic should be prepared to slow down and may be reduced to one lane. Be aware of rough road conditions. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: October 2015

PROJECT: Highway 358 Bridge over Wood Mountain Creek

ESTIMATED COST: \$5.8 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: July 7, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Construction of a bridge on Highway 358 over Wood Mountain Creek approximately 25.0 km south of Limerick, Saskatchewan IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: This section of highway will be restricted to legal load limits and 4.3 m wide lane.

ESTIMATED COMPLETION: August 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 937(Culvert Installation) – Work has resumed

ESTIMATED COST: \$1.3 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: June 9, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Installation of culvert through Highway 937, 19.1 km west of its junction with Highway 939. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: The highway at this location is closed to traffic due to washout. Watch for equipment and people working. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: August 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Highway 980 Bridge replacement near Armit

ESTIMATED COST: \$500,000 START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: Week of July 13, 2015 DESCRIPTION: Construction of a bridge on Highway 980 over an unnamed creek near Armit, Saskatchewan. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS: Single lane local detour will be open for the duration of the project. Public traffic can expect minor delays. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: August 2015

PROJECT/WORK: Stony Rapids Airport Rehab, Apron Expansion and Access Road near Stony Rapids

ESTIMATED COST: \$15.1 million START OF THIS YEAR'S CONSTRUCTION: June 1, 2015 DESCRIPTION: 1.3 km of grading and paving on Highway 905; grading and paving on the runway, taxiway and apron; and rehabilitation of the airfield electrical system. IMPACT ON MOTORISTS/AIRTRAFFIC: Public traffic should not experience delays. Normal operation of the airport will be temporarily impacted during construction. ESTIMATED COMPLETION: October 2015

NOTE: This is a snapshot of various provincial highway construction projects throughout Saskatchewan and can range from capital work, maintenance work to repairs, depending on the significance and length of a specific project. Contractors and crew work schedules can vary. Project completion and traffic opening times are estimates only.
