DIRECTOR'S ORDER

FIRE BAN

The Wildfire Act, S.S. 2014, c.W-13.01

WHEREAS

A. In the opinion of the Executive Director of Wildfire Management Branch of the Ministry of Environment, an extreme fire hazard exists in that area within the Province of Saskatchewan set forth below.

THEREFORE, I, Steve J. Roberts, Executive Director of Wildfire Management Branch of the Ministry of Environment, appointed pursuant to section 7 of <u>The Wildfire Act</u>, do hereby order, pursuant to section 41 of that Act, that:

- (a) The setting or propagation of any outdoor fire, other than a fire using charcoal briquettes in a firebox, CSA-approved self-contained heating devices, pressurized stoves or other facility approved by the Ministry of Environment is hereby prohibited;
- (b) All burn notification numbers issued pursuant to Section 17 of <u>The Wildfire Act</u> for outdoor fires in the area described below are hereby revoked effective the date of this order; and
- (c) The discharge of fireworks is hereby prohibited.

The lands within Sask at chewan to which this fire ban order applies include:

Within that portion of Saskatchewan lying south of the Churchill River:

- 1. All provincial Crown land, and
- 2. All provincial parks and provincial recreation sites as described in The Parks Regulations, 1991, including Lac La Ronge Provincial Park.

This order takes effect 11:00 AM, August 31, 2017.
