

Saskatchewan Archives Week 2017 Events

- **Regina:**

The Provincial Archives of Saskatchewan, in partnership with the Saskatchewan Council for Archives and Archivists (SCAA), is celebrating Archives Week by hosting a celebrity reading event, "Perspectives on the North West Resistance."

The evening will also feature appearances by characters from the local play, "The Trial of Louis Riel". This year marks the 50th anniversary of the play, with a large anniversary tour planned for later in the year.

This free event is open to the adult public and takes place in Regina on February 8 from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. at Bushwakker Brewpub. Refreshments are available to purchase.

- **Saskatoon:**

A historic film night will be presented by the Provincial Archives of Saskatchewan, the City of Saskatoon Archives, the University of Saskatchewan Archives and Special Collections, the Saskatoon Public Library - Local History, and the Western Development Museum - George Shepard Research Library.

Short films will be screened at the Roxy Theatre on Thursday February 8 at 7 p.m. Admission is free.

- **Humboldt**

An open house event will be hosted by The Archives of Humboldt Museum and Gallery, including an exhibit of archival photos.

This event will take place on Tuesday, February 7 from 1:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. Refreshments and cake will be provided.

- **La Ronge**

An open house event will take place at Pahkisimon Nuye?áh Library System in Air Ronge, hosted by The Northern Saskatchewan Archives. Feature displays include Norman MacAuley, Wollaston Lake Caribou Hunt, Kiwetinohk (Northern Saskatchewan rock paintings), history and genealogy, and tours.

The open house will take place on Tuesday February 7 from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.

- **St. Isidore de Bellevue**

A display will be presented at Le Rendez-vous cultural centre for the week of February 1 to 11, featuring archival photographs and documents and short films. There will also be a Tea and Treasures open house at this location on February 6.

- **Whitewood**

An open house exhibit will be held by the Whitewood Tourism and Heritage Association at the Archives building from Monday to Friday, 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.

- **Lloydminster:**

Displays will be set up in senior residences throughout the week, and include the Pioneer Lodge, Hemstock Assisted Living Residence, and Hearthstone Place.

- **Melfort**

The Melfort & District Museum will host "Coffee & Conversation, Coffee Row Throughout the Ages", featuring stories and refreshments.

This event will take place on Wednesday, February 15 from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. and is free and open to the public.

- **North Battleford**

The City of North Battleford Historic Archives is setting up an exhibit of interactive display boards and maps at Battlefords and District Co-operatives Territorial Place Mall called "Corner Stores in North Battleford from 1905 – 1980."
