

Backgrounder

Investing in water and wastewater infrastructure to strengthen Saskatchewan communities

The governments of Canada and Saskatchewan will each provide more than \$27.3 million for the following eight infrastructure projects under the New Building Canada Plan's Provincial-Territorial Infrastructure Component—National and Regional Projects. Including the recipients' contributions, more than \$82.1 million will be invested in total.
