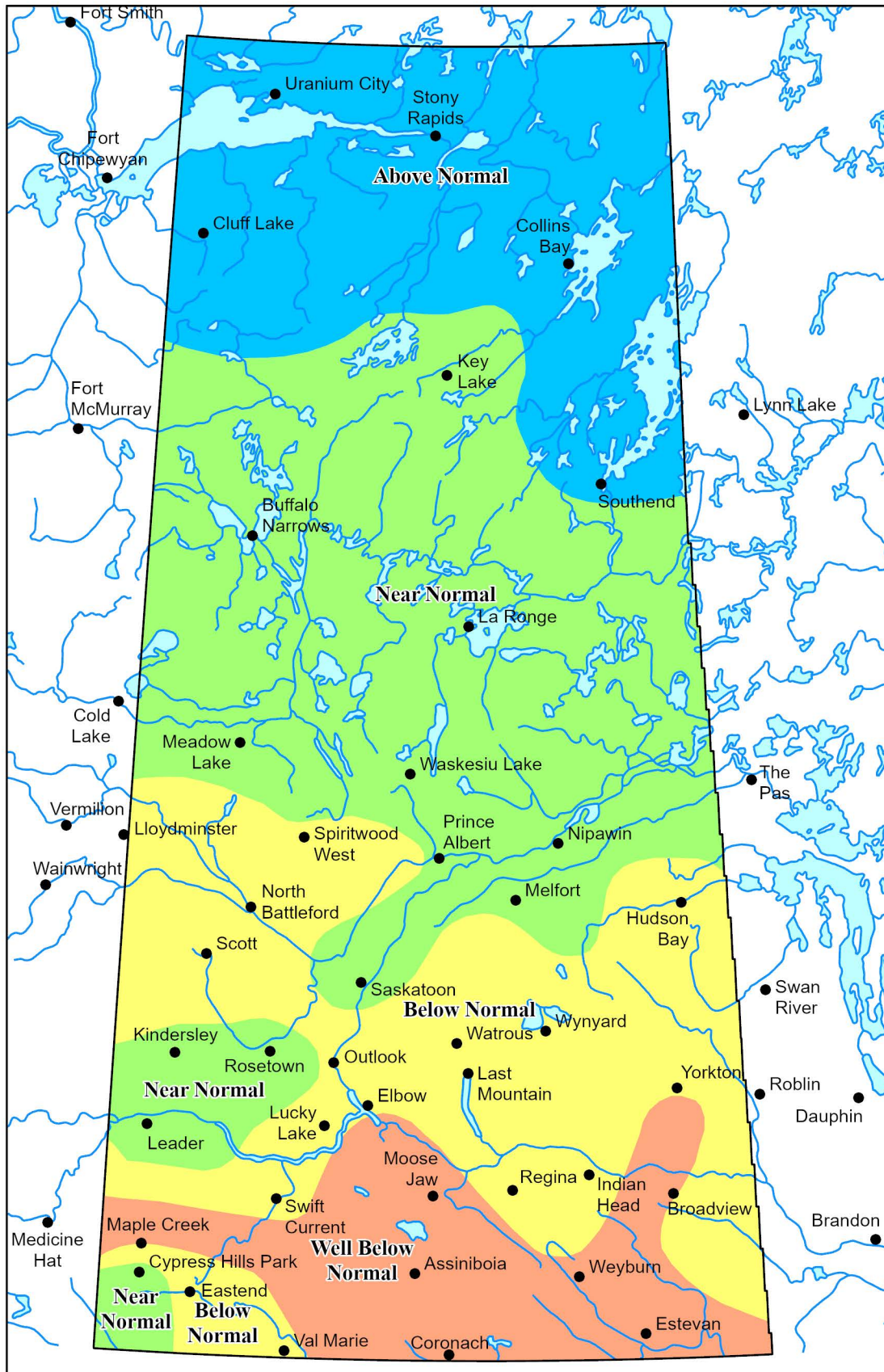


SPRING RUNOFF POTENTIAL AS OF MARCH 01, 2021



Above normal precipitation prior to runoff and/or a faster than typical rate of melt may result in significantly higher runoff.

Conditions can vary considerably over short distances.

Projected runoff is based on sparse, variable, and often conflicting snow accumulation estimates.

Runoff boundaries should be considered approximate.
