Backgrounder

Since 2007-08, Government funding for people with disabilities has increased by an estimated \$502.9 million or 234.0 per cent. The 2023-24 Budget includes \$717.8 million, an increase of \$38.8 million for enhanced programming and increased program utilization for people with disabilities.
