

First Nations and Métis Funding 2023-24

The 2023-24 Budget provides approximately \$249.1 million for targeted program funding primarily for First Nation and Métis organizations. This represents an increase of \$15.9 million or 6.8 per cent. This funding excludes provincial expenditures that may be accessed by the general population which also provide benefit to First Nation and Métis people. This only captures funding from executive government. It does not include Crown corporations, school divisions, post-secondary institutions or the Saskatchewan Health Authority.
