

## Backgrounder

### City of Saskatoon to benefit from improved public transit and a new leisure centre

Joint funding through the Public Transit Infrastructure Stream (PTIS) and the Community, Culture and Recreation Infrastructure Stream (CCRIS) of the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program will support public transportation projects and one recreation project in Saskatoon.

The Government of Canada is investing \$60,789,075 to support these projects. The Government of Saskatchewan is investing \$33,986,861, and the City of Saskatoon is investing \$57,196,751 toward these projects.
