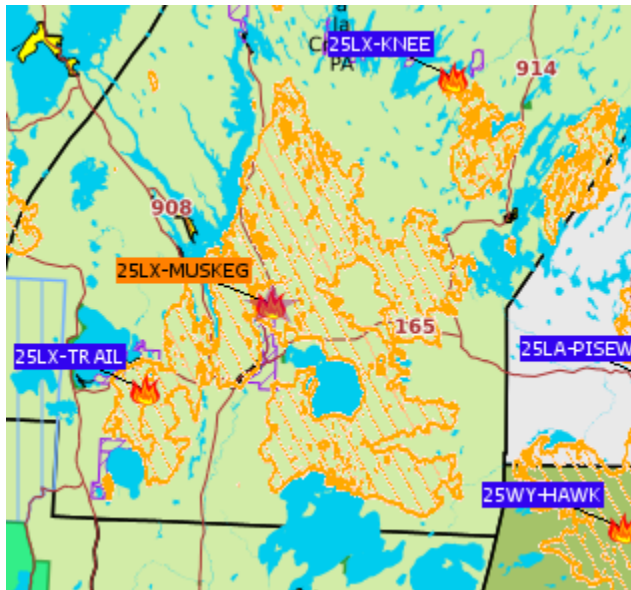

25LX-MUSKEG (North of La Plonge Indian Reserve and Beauval)

| Weather | Max Temp: 30C. Min RH: 27%. Winds: Light and variable, W-NW 5-10km/h gusting 15km/h at times. Precipitation: Nil. Humidex: 28-31C. An inversion aloft (< 1km) will linger until 12:00CST. Upper ridge brings partly cloudy to sunny skies and light winds with warm and dry conditions to the region. Chance of a lake breeze, increasing wind speeds and causing wind direction to shift. |
| Impacts | Values lost, Possibility of intermittent highway closure and reduced visibility due to fire activity. |

25LX-MUSKEG (North of La Plonge Indian Reserve and Beauval) continued

Division B and C are being monitored. In Division D, crews will continue actioning hotspots and utilizing porta tank and hose in grids JM and JK 124. Other crews will also be actioning hotspots along highway 165 with floater support. In Division E, crews will continue patrolling and extinguishing hotspots along highway 918 with water tenders. Fire is listed as 80% contained.
