

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S ORDER REVOKING FIRE BAN

The Wildfire Act, s. 41

On June 13, 2025, I, Steve Roberts, Vice President, Operations, Saskatchewan Public Safety Agency, ordered a ban on the starting of any open fire, the discharge of fireworks and revoked the burn notification numbers issued, in the following areas in the Province of Saskatchewan:

- All vacant Crown land, as defined in *The Wildfire Act*;
- The provincial forest, including the provincial forest within the boundaries of the Northern Saskatchewan Administration District; and
- The provincial parks and provincial recreations sites as described in The Parks Act and The Parks Regulations, 1991.

within the portion of Saskatchewan lying within:

- the southern boundary of the provincial forest, north to the southern boundary of the Churchill River; and
- the Alberta border east to the Manitoba border.

It is advisable and in the public interest to revoke the said fire ban.

I, Steve Roberts, Vice President, Operations, Saskatchewan Public Safety Agency, pursuant to section 41(1) of *The Wildfire Act*, do hereby order that the ban in the areas mentioned above is hereby revoked, effective at 5:00pm the date of this Order.
