

Regina Bypass Will Improve Safety and Save \$380 million

Backgrounder

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Key Facts

- Projected Savings - \$380 million
- Value for Money – 16.8%
- Project investment (includes construction, maintenance, operations and rehabilitation over 30 years) - \$1.88 billion
- Expected job creation – 8,200 construction-related and 11,300 over all
- About 40 km of new, four-lane highway
- Twinning about 5 km of Highway 6
- 12 Overpasses
- Numerous service roads
- All construction complete – fall 2019
 - Phase 1 fall 2017 – includes overpasses at Balgonie, White City, the vicinity of Tower Road and Highway 33, a new four-lane road between Highway 1 and 33, east of Tower Road, and associated service roads.
 - Phase 2 fall 2019 – Overpass at the Pilot Butte Access and all other components.

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
