

Backgrounder – Charity Championship

- On August 11 at 12 p.m., up to 44 teams of four people each will begin the competition to win a portion of a \$25,000 prize pool for the charity or non-profit organization of their choice.
- The \$25,000 prize pool will be divided among the top 16th finishers for their charity or non-profit organization.
- An additional \$2,000 in prize money will be divided among the top four finishers for their team.
- Teams will compete in the west parking lot at Casino Regina (1880 Saskatchewan Drive, Regina, SK) in a 100' inflatable obstacle course. The fastest 16 teams will advance to a seeded bracketstyle tournament.
- Prior to the competition, teams will fundraise for the charity or non-profit organization of their choice through FundRazr.com. The more funds each team raises for their charity or non-profit organization, the greater advantage they will have in the competition. All funds raised are directed to the team's charity or non-profit organization.
- The Charity Championship prize breakdown is as follows:
 - First place finishers will earn \$10,000 for their charity/non-profit and \$1,000 cash for their team.
 - Second place finishers will earn \$5,000 for their charity/non-profit and \$500 for their team.
 - Third place finishers will earn \$4,000 for their charity/non-profit and \$300 for their team
 - o Fourth place finishers will earn \$3,000 for their charity/non-profit and \$200 for their team.
 - o Fifth to 16th place finishers will earn \$250 for their charity/non-profit.
 - Top fundraising team will earn \$1,000 for their team or charity/non-profit.
 - Best FundRazr profile video or picture will earn \$750 cash for their team or charity/non-profit.
 - Best team costume and spirit will earn \$500 cash for their team or charity/non-profit.
- Charity or non-profit organizations must adhere to SaskGaming's Community Relations Policy.
 Charities and non-profits organizations that support the following endeavours aren't eligible to participate:
 - Political groups or events;
 - Religious groups, events or projects;
 - Individual pursuits;
 - Sports teams;
 - Out-of-province events or travel expenses;
 - Annual general meetings;
 - o Publications, theatrical productions or video productions; and
 - o Graduations or family reunions.
- Registration will close when all 44 spots are full or on August 9 whichever comes first.
