July 24, 2018	Saskatchewan Health Authority - Biggar	A Telehealth camera was stolen from an unlocked room at Biggar Health Centre.	\$2,300	An internal investigation was conducted. The incident was reported to the RCMP. The perpetrator was not identified. The SHA has since strengthened controls to better safeguard assets.
July 30, 2018	Saskatchewan Health Authority – Prince Albert	A patient and employees at Victoria Hospital in Prince Albert reported cash missing from the patient’s locked belongings drawer.	\$800	An internal investigation was conducted. The incident was reported to the Prince Albert Police Service. The perpetrator was not identified. A cheque was issued to the patient in the amount of \$800. The SHA is taking steps to review and correct its processes regarding the security of patient belongings.
August 7, 2018	Saskatchewan Health Authority – Regina	A Microsoft Surface Pro laptop was stolen from a locked office at Pasqua Hospital Eye Centre in Regina.	\$1,000	An internal investigation was conducted. The incident was reported to the Regina Police Service. The perpetrator was not identified.
